

AMBICO'S "MARINE DOOR" MEETS A-60 (IMO) PERFORMANCE STANDARD

AMBICO Limited manufactures a fire tested A-60 Marine Door, meeting the criteria in the U.S. Coast Guard approval category 164.136. The door is a swinging door, constructed of stainless steel with a 127 x 286 mm window.

Successful testing was completed in 2005 at Southwest Research Institute in accordance with IMO Resolution A.754(18), *Recommendation on Fire Resistance Tests for 'A,' 'B,' and 'F' Class Division, November 4, 1993 Edition*, for a duration of one hour.

Marine doors must meet a number of criteria in conformance with International Marine Organization (IMO) standards:

- an A-60 fire rating
- temperature rise requirements
- positive pressure standards

AMBICO Marine Doors are available in a range of materials such as #304 and #316 stainless steel or galvanneal steel.
